Set me back \$31 at my local BWS. I'm sure there are better prices out there. Cliff Edge Shiraz has been in good form of late. It's a sweeter fruit profile than we generally expect to see under this label, or from this estate, though it's immaculately balanced and presented and has just-enough enough pepper-spice to keep lovers of this label happy. Spice notes though are certainly in shorter supply here than usual. Creamy mouthfeel, floral aspects, sweet raspberry and black cherry, perhaps just into plum. It's a seductive wine, no doubt. Mount Langi Ghiran is certainly putting out excellent reds right now.

(30 percent new French oak) Bright violet. Potent, mineral-accented dark berry, cola and licorice scents are complemented by hints of allspice, mocha and candied Flowers. Fleshy and appealingly sweet, offering concentrated cassis, cherry-vanilla and violet pastille flavors that are underscored by a vein of smoky minerality. Displays excellent depth and energy and shows impressive focus on the long, sweet finish, which is framed by smooth, harmonious tannins.
