

# MOUNT LANGI GHIRAN

The 2014 MOUNT LANGI GHIRAN Vine Road Shiraz is sourced from premium cool climate Victorian vineyards; predominantly the Grampians including a portion from the Mount Langi Ghiran vineyards, home of the iconic Langi Shiraz.

## TASTING NOTE

**Colour:** Bright, deep purple.

**Aromas:** Spiced aromatics and black fruits.

**Palate:** Clear black berry fruits form the core, laced with spices of clove and pepper. Finely structured tannins frame this medium bodied, approachable and generous wine, finishing with good balance.

**Cellar:** Drink now until 2020

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## WINEMAKING NOTE

The 2014 vintage provided good conditions for grape growing, with a dry and reasonably warm season. Due to a cold snap in spring the crops were low yielding resulting in high quality fruit with intense flavours and complexity. This wine showcases the ‘Langi’ spice, complimented by generous fruit characters.
