Bright, medium to light yellow hue. The bouquet is smoky and showing some of the same struck-flint character as the Cliff Edge, but with more nuances to it. Traces of malt and peach nectar. The wine is rich and intense and yet refined and softly-textured, the palate deep in flavour and long on the aftertaste. An excellent riesling.

Expected development showing in the colour but the bouquet, and in particular the palate, are as fresh as they are complex. This is as much about structure and complexity as it is about fruit - a Rheingau austerity. Right now it's in transition between youth and (moderate) maturity, and with time needed to complete the transition.

Forty year old riesling vines. It's been in bottle since August 2015 but it's only being released now, in September/October 2017. The intensity on offer here is quite something. It sets it apart from the outset. It's a wildly expressive riesling, all leaves and dirt, citrus and florals, like walking into an orchard with its fruits at various stages of crispness and decay, honey dripping from the odd branch. It's a ride.

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
