It's a little known fact that Mount Langi Ghiran planted Sangiovese in 1992 and had its first proper harvest of the variety's grapes in 1998. It's light in both colour and flavour but it still manages to make a good impression. This is an attractive style of wine. Cherries, dry Aussie bush spices, florals maybe, leathery notes. It's fractionally developed, in a positive way; it aids the mellow impression. Big tick for drinkability.

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
