

MOUNT LANGI GHIRAN

The Hollows Vineyard located on the Northern slope of the Mount Langi Ghiran forms the core component of this wine.

The Hollows vineyard was established after Trevor Mast had completed an exhaustive search for land to expand the estate's vineyard area. The site was chosen for its protection from the cold south westerlies and its variety of aspects and high-quality soils – very similar, in fact, to the estate's original plantings.

The 2016 Hollows Shiraz is an approachable and generous wine, displaying fragrant perfumes, complex spice and a luscious core of red and black fruits that beautifully showcases the Grampians region.

TASTING NOTE

Colour: Crimson with deep purple hues.

Aromas: Lifted, aromatic, full of florals and spice.

Palate: Core of black fruits layered with dried florals and clove spice. Generous soft tannins and lively acidity create an approachable wine with great length and balance.
