2015 Billi Billi Shiraz - Reviews & Accolades

Mount Langi Ghiran's entry-level shiraz is artfully blended from various Victorian regions. In 2015 the grapes came from the Grampians, Swan Hill and Heathcote areas. It has a medium to full ruby colour with a slight purple tint, the bouquet mellow and forward, showing savoury fresh-earth nuances and a degree of matured complexity. The palate is soft, savoury, medium-bodied and easy drinking, the tannins gentle and light. An excellent early-drinking red, which will keep happily for up to 10 years.

Lurid ruby. Fresh blueberry, potpourri and a hint of vanilla on the intensely perfumed nose. Shows very good depth and focus to its juicy red and blue fruit flavors, with no excess fat. Round, even tannins lend shape to a very long, smooth, spice-tinged finish that leaves notes of cherry and mint behind. This Shiraz delivers outstanding value.

The great-value Mount Langi Ghiran 2015 Billi Billi Shiraz comes from a brand based on Langi Ghiran and bought-in Grampians fruit. The wine has 14.5 per cent alcohol, purple hues and spicy blackcurrant on the front palate. The middle palate introduces Morello cherry, mint chocolate, capers and mocha oak and peppery tannins play at the finish.

Another of the real 'go to' wines of the modern Australian wine scene. It's a sweet, ripe, cherry-berried example of north-west Victorian shiraz. It doesn't stamp its feet for quality but it does make a good account of itself. Good-to-very-good value.
