A roll of lemon curd, lime, Thai herb, ripe brown pear and bitter almond scents kick off the dialogue. Again, this estate is not afraid of exploiting grape skin phenolics for their grip, texture and capacity to balance a wine across a litany of dishes. Very Old World in its composure; Australian in its joyousness. An ode to a challenging year!

Light to medium yellow colour, with a malt and almond meal bouquet, a very different bouquet to the Cliff Edge from the same vineyard and vintage. The acid level is significantly higher here, too, and the wine is tight and nervy, crisp and refreshing and also quite complex. It's almost as if there is a little barrel-work involved, such is the layering of the bouquet and texture of the palate. A very fine wine, drinking nicely now and well worth cellaring

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
