

# MOUNT LANGI GHIRAN

## 2018 Cliff Edge Riesling

The 2018 Cliff Edge Riesling is sourced solely from the Langi Old Block Riesling, planted in 1975. Langi's very cool climate, together with granite sands and minimal irrigation delivers great purity and stunning natural acidity, creating a wine of great balance and cellaring potential.

The 2018 vintage saw lower yields across our vineyards, although the harvest may be smaller, the quality is high. Concentrated flavours and natural acidity remained elevated throughout the season. The Riesling was harvested in early March, just before a looming rain event, capturing the flavour profile and acid structure desired. The 2018 Cliff Edge Riesling is a wine that shows great varietal and regional qualities.

### TASTING NOTE:

**Colour:** Pale straw with a vibrant green apple tinge.

**Nose:** Florals and spice, layered with citrus, stone fruits and lime pith.

**Palate:** An intensely varietal wine with those aromas of spiced pear and white stone fruits dominating the palate. Depth and texture are persistent though the mid palate, with delicate florals and citrus characters adding further complexity. The fine acid structure completes this wine, delivering balance and length.

**Cellar:** Up to 10 years.

**Region:** Grampians

**Vineyard(s):** Mount Langi Ghiran

**Vine age:** 43 years

**Soil:** Granite sand over red clay

**Harvest date:** Late March 2018

**Harvest method:** Hand harvested

### WINEMAKING NOTE:

**Fermentation method:** This fruit was hand harvest and pressed to stainless steel tank where it saw a slow, cool fermentation to preserve aroma and flavour.
